

What is the Triage Team?

Our new Triage Team, funded through the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) triage grant, will work with Local Education Agency (LEAs) and programs to develop a multi-tiered system of prevention, intervention, and triage support, including: early identification, crisis intervention and stabilization. An outreach team is also available to build relationships between LEAs, preschool programs, communities, families, and children, while providing resource connections, upcoming parent trainings, and information about local events.

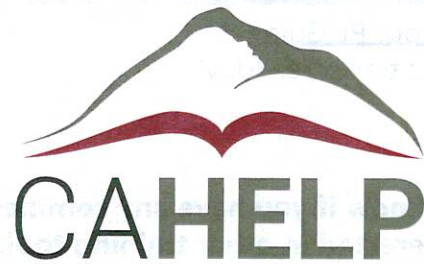

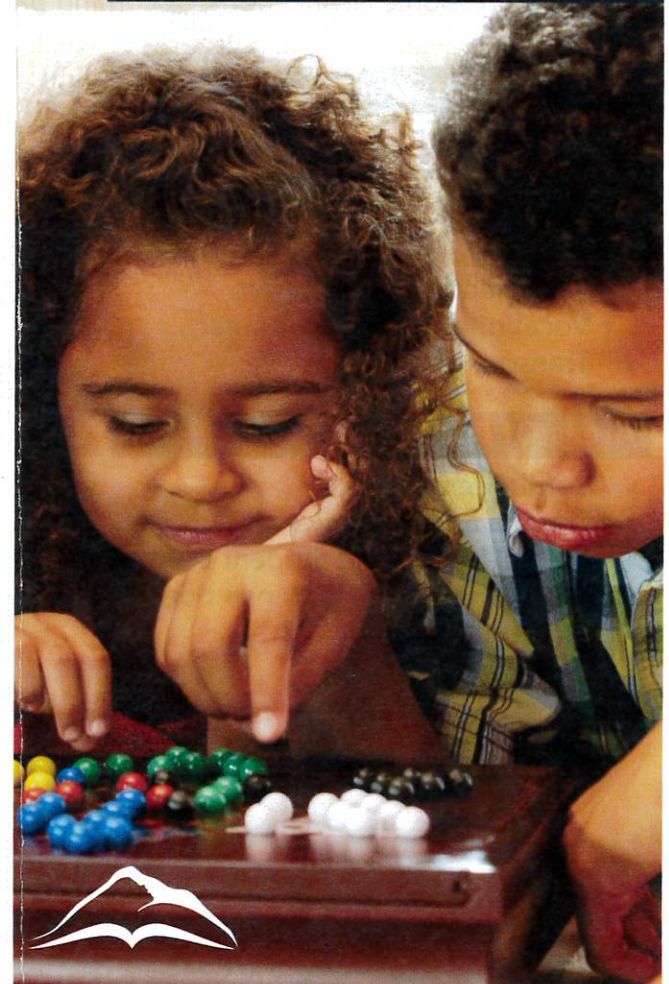
