

## College Fee Application Waiver Info

### USC Fee Application Waiver:

If paying the application causes a financial hardship, applicants may apply for a fee waiver by obtaining a letter verifying financial hardship from their high school or college counselor. Fee waivers are also available to students applying online.

International students are not eligible for application fee waivers and USC does not accept international reply coupons for application payments. Full-time USC employees and their dependents are exempt from paying the application fee.

### CSU Fee Application Waiver:

In case of financial hardship, campuses allow a limited number of application fee waivers for residents of California. If you file the admission application via CSU Mentor, the fee waiver request is included in the online system as part of the application process. You will be notified at the time you apply online if you qualify for the fee waiver. In situations where the online application is unable to determine your eligibility for a fee waiver, you will need to submit the [PDF Request for Application Fee Waiver](#) directly to the campus admission office(s). The campus will inform you if you do not qualify for the fee waiver. Only California residents are eligible for application fee waivers.

### UC Fee Application Waiver:

UC will waive application fees for up to four campuses for qualified students who otherwise would be unable to apply for admission. To be accepted for the fee waiver program, you must meet specific requirements related to your family income and size. The fee waiver program is for United States citizens and permanent residents only.

**You can apply for a fee waiver within the online application and be notified immediately whether you have qualified.**

If the student has applied and is denied the fee waiver, he should wait until he is billed and then send his College Board fee waiver request to the Application Processing Service at the address provided on the bill. The fee waiver covers the application fee for up to four campuses; the student will have to pay the fee for more than four campuses.

**College Board Fee Application Waiver:** Available from your high school counselor. Submit it with your application.

### **The California Association of County Veterans Service Officers (CACVSO)**

The California College Fee Waiver (CFW) program benefits the spouse and children of U.S. veterans. Students meeting the eligibility criteria may get their college fees waived if they attend a California Community College, a California State University, or University of California campus.

To be eligible, students must:

- » Have a parent who is a disabled veteran (0% or more disabled); **or**
- » Have a spouse or domestic partner who is service-connected (S/C) deceased or rated 100% S/C disabled.
- » Be a child earning less than \$11,201.00 per year (student's income, not parents').

### **Seattle Pacific Fee Application Waiver:**
